Petrov Day in Russian folklore was called the "top" of summer. On this day, the Petrov Fasting ended and the hay season began.

Haymaking usually lasted two to three weeks and was considered difficult but festive in the Russian countryside: both women and men wore holiday clothes for haymaking, after work round dances, games and dances were arranged.



Since ancient times on this day, parents presented their adult son with a new braid in which he went out into the world as a full-grown adult worker.

Opening of Folk Fest: 12.00 - 13.00

Participants:

A prayer service and holy water lighting of new Kosovorotkas, which the Administration passes to the pupils of children's homes in the region / city.

Parade of participants and guests: 13.00 - 13.30 (implemented where possible)

- passage of dance groups: with the performance of elements of Russian folk dances;
- the passage of theater groups (buffoons, stilts, etc.)
